English Language Arts

Writing

The learner will....

- Write a research paper
- Cite sources using correct format
- Identify multiple points of view to correlate with writing
- Write sentences correctly using regular and irregular verbs

Reading Comprehension

The learner will....

- Identify main ideas that are implied
- Solve difficult vocabulary using knowledge of Greek and Latin roots and suffixes
- Read scientific and technical texts like an expert

Math

The learner will....

- Multiply whole numbers, mixed numbers, fractions, and decimals
- Divide whole numbers and decimals using the standard algorithm
- Divide fractions and decimals using pictorial models
- Solve real-world word problems involving multiplying and dividing, fractions and decimals

Science

The learner will....

- Demonstrate the flow of electricity in circuits
- Identify and describe sources of thermal energy
- Explain the cause of static electricity
- Understand light travel and its interaction with objects
- Identify uses of sound energy such as sonar

Social Studies

The learner will....

- Explain the purposes for colonization in the United States
- Describe the accomplishments from colonists such as William Bradford and Anne Hutchinson
- Analyze the causes and effects historic events prior to the American Revolution
- Identify the Founding Fathers and Patriot heroes from the Revolutionary Period
